After a whole year of preparation, we are thrilled to welcome you to the eighth edition of Paral-lel Festival. It's always a joy to return to this beautiful corner of the Catalan Pyrenees and share with you three days of music, nature, and connection. That is the essence of what Paral-lel is all about.

Since 2016, Paral-lel has been a meeting point for those who value sonic exploration, simplicity, and a deep bond with the natural environment. Our aim has always been to create an intimate and meaningful experience, and this year we aim to relive those unique moments that are so much part of our common story.

With arms wide open, we invite you to dive into this weekend with curiosity and presence. Please make sure to read our recommendations within this booklet in order to stay safe and get the most out of your experience with us.

Our home at Port del Comte welcomes us back with a few exciting changes this year. Most notably, we'll be extending Sunday's closing set until 10 pm so we can enjoy the sunset together, dancing through those final closing tracks that make Paral-lel so unforgettable.

We're also introducing a shuttle service from the nearby town of Sant Llorenç, paired with accommodation options for those who don't manage to book a stay near the venue.

To make your experience even better, we've added more shaded areas, including new bedouin tents and bamboo structures built by a bio-construction collective. At night, new lighting installations will help guide your way and bring an extra layer of atmosphere to the festival's landscapes.

As always, we remain committed to sustainability. This year we've introduced some dry ecological toilets and are conducting an environmental impact study to better understand where we can keep improving. We see this as an ongoing journey: one we walk together, respectfully and mindfully.

A small but important reminder: the mountain weather can be extreme, and this summer has been exceptionally hot. Please wear sunscreen and a hat, stay hydrated, and rest often in the shade - especially on the dancefloor, where both sunny and shaded spots will be available. Take care of your body so you can enjoy the full journey.

- → You can also top up at our top-up booth, paying with card or cash.




Keep hold of your wristband after the festival! You'll need it to claim your refund of any unused money.

WORKSHOP ①

EXPLORE THE ART OF SONIC ATMOSPHERES.

Workshop by BEFACO. With Patricia Usero (Puntalaberinto), Manu Retamero (ëgg) and Diego de León (Befacosynth)

→ Saturday, July 26th, 11:00 AM—2:00 PM

This workshop is an immersive experience combining talks, demonstrations, and collective creation to explore ambient music through modular synthesis. Guided by artists such as Patricia Usero, Manu Retamero, and Diego de León, participants will delve into techniques for generating drones, textures, and spatial environments. The workshop concludes with a collective jam session—the Megadrone—connecting all systems in a shared sonic ritual. No prior experience is required; just curiosity and a desire to explore sound.

WORKSHOP 2

"MUTANT SOUNDS - VOICES, TEXTURES AND RHYTHMS IN MUTATION" BY ARTURIA AND ZENTRALMEDIA. Workshop by Samuel Escudero

→ Sunday, July 27th, 11:00 AM—1:00 PM

Mutant Sounds is an interactive lab within the Paral-lel Plus+ 2025 program, where participants co-create synthetic textures, analog rhythms, and vocoder-processed voices using the Arturia MiniFreak and DrumBrute Impact. The audience is organized into creative teams by roles (texture, beat, and voice) to design sounds based on thematic challenges and participatory dynamics. With a playful and collaborative approach, real-time tools are explored, experimentation is encouraged, and the session ends with a mini collective jam.



RECOMMENDATIONS



Do not build a fire or cook to prevent forest fire.

Danger: do not touch the electric fences.



It can get very hot during the day and cold at night as you are in the high mountains. Bring warm clothes including a rain jacket, and don't forget to protect yourself from the sun during the day.



The grounds need to be completely empty by Monday at 11 am at the absolute latest.



Go to the meeting point 15 minutes earlier before departure to catch one of our buses: Sunday (11 pm) / Monday (9 am, 10 am and 11 am).



Use your garbage bag to store all waste and leave it in the designated containers before leaving. If you need more waste disposal materials, please ask at the Info Point.



We will not tolerate any sexist, racist or discriminatory attitude of any kind. If you see or experience something that doesn't seem right to you, go to the Lilac Point or talk to someone from the organization.



Take care of yourself, hydrate, eat well and remember to rest. You can get information at the "Safe Party" stand for substance use or consumption, and if you are not feeling well, please get help at the first aid station.



The information point will be open for any incident at the following times: Friday from 3 pm to 12 am / Saturday from 10 am to 12 am / Sunday from 10 am to 11 pm / Monday from 8 am to 11 am.
